


PRESENT: Vestry Members: Mmes. Aldrich, Bourque, Chipman-Bergsma, DePlonty, Horst, Neveu;

Diane stated Dennis Vierra has raised the snowplow price to \$30 a plow. She also asked Dave to ready the snowblower and equipment for the winter season (shovels, salt, WD40, blower, etc.). Kaysner finished sealing concrete. Cal moved the parking bumpers and put on the bench covers. Cal also gave his key to the fire department because the safe box key no longer worked due to rekeying the lock. Pam will get a key for Cal. Cal has stated he will run for vestry and would take the Jr. Warden job.
