- 9. <u>Junior Warden's Report</u>: Cal Woodard reported on the consumption of natural gas for the past year, 2022. The total for energy including electrical was \$20,000. He has researched the Michigan Interfaith Power and Light and they referred us to E.Z. Breeze Air, LLC. The system that he is looking at would take heat that is at the top of the church and would be transferred back down. This system would safe approximately 30 to 40 percent of the energy we are currently using. He has received information back and will be reporting back to us after he researches the quotes, etc. further. He has talked to Jeff Roy about the electrical part of the project, and it is agreed that it needs to be aesthetically pleasing. Mr. Jeff Roy indicated there would need to be a meeting prior to installation with the product salesperson Roger Ciallus. Cal Woodard is also investigating how these air systems would be lifted and attached to the ceiling. Cal Woodard also questioned whether the historical society would need to be involved in this change in the interior of the building. There was discussion regarding how these would be attached to the ceiling. There are ten hanging lights in the main portion of the church. For

informational purposes Cal Woodard has contacted Everything Electric regarding the florescent lamps that are broken in the church. The type that we have are no longer made, however there is a LED product that could replace the current broken light. In time he would like to have an electrician replace them all upstairs. Changing the lights are difficult and it would be good to purchase new lights LED and have Roy Electric replace the lights. They would cost less to operate and would give more light.

- 10. Cal reported that there is a new company in town that will be recycling old electrical products such as TV's, computer monitors, appliances, etc. for free. The company will be located on Fort Street.
- 11. Sandy inquired if we could repair the pews that are cracked perhaps with a clear silicon product as a possible product to repair the crack. It was decided that perhaps that we could experiment with that. There is an issue with the humidity in the church that causes these cracks in the pews.
